**2 – My DEPENDANCY provides

**A – Believers CHOOSE to
SERVE**

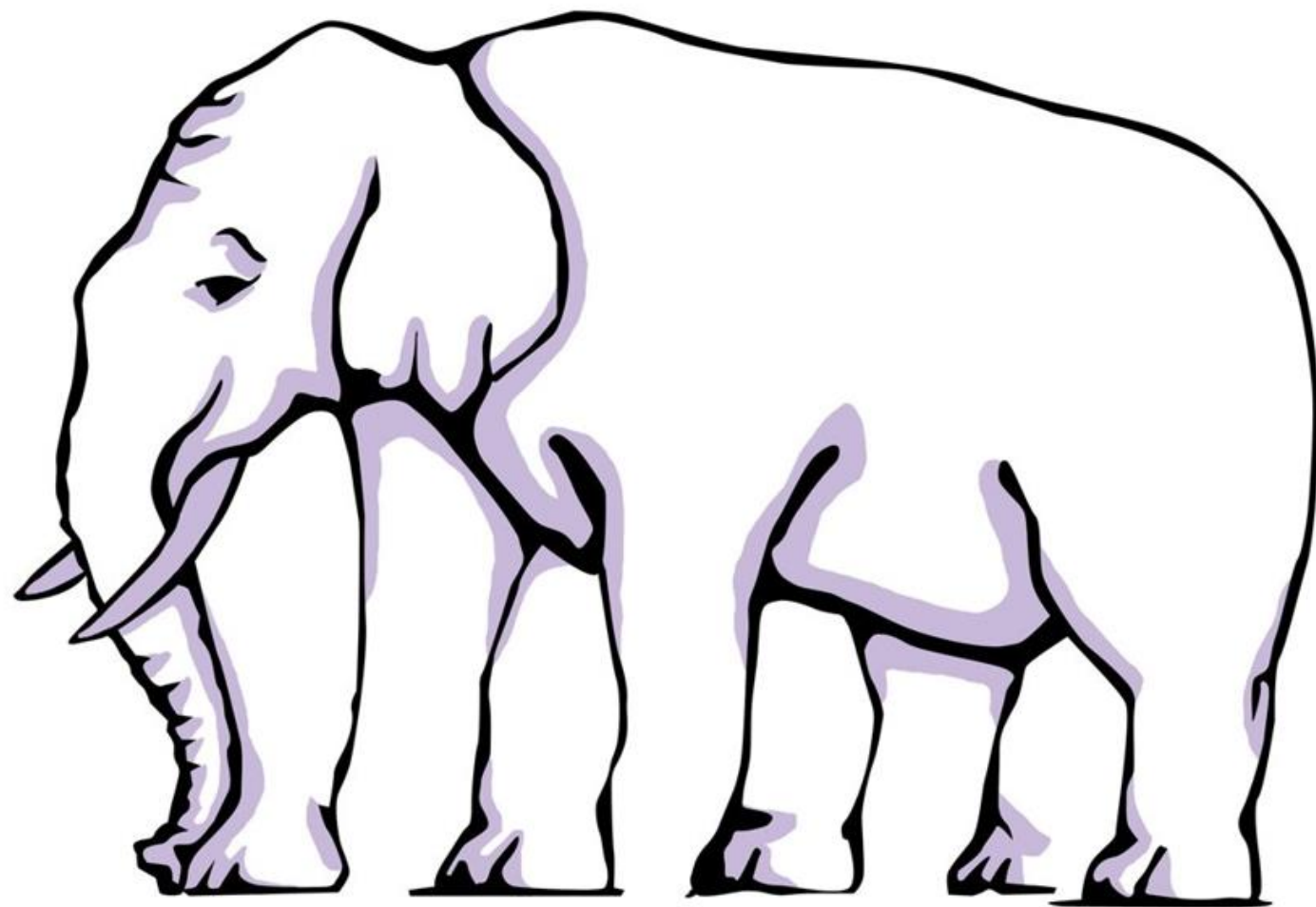
**1 – Making DISCIPLES will go

so Life could be EASY**

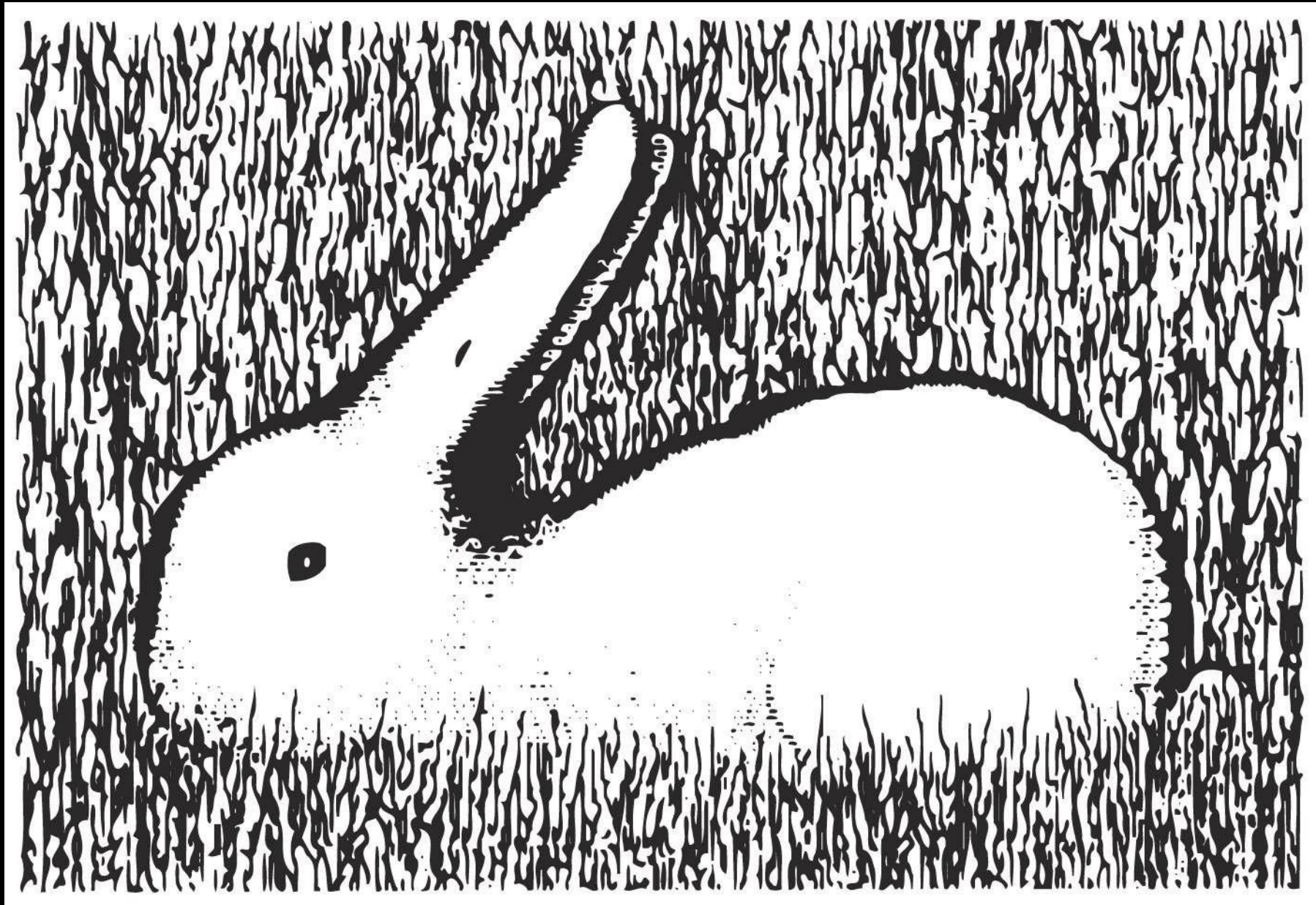
B – Everyone has a CHOICE!

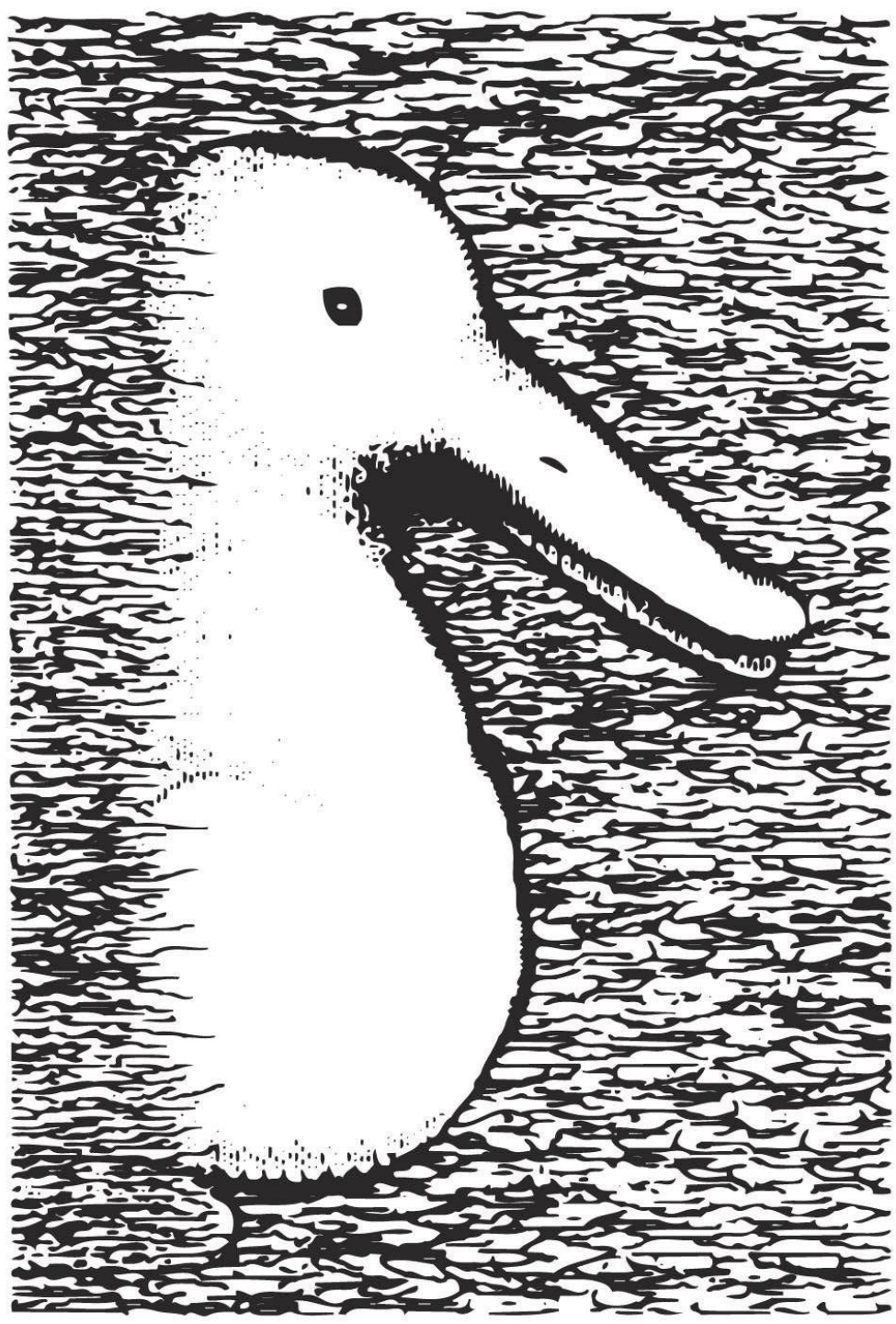
**1 – Some will ACCEPT and

UNHINDERED
(akōlytōs)
free,
nothing to stop,
or be in the way**
